

Postdoctoral position in functional genomics:

The Ahituv lab (<http://pharm.ucsf.edu/ahituv>) is searching for a postdoctoral fellow in functional genomics. The lab uses various genomic technologies to identify gene regulatory elements and link them to various phenotypes, including human disease and morphological differences between species. In addition, it is developing massively parallel reporter assays (MPRAs) and CRISPR-based screens to functionally characterize thousands of gene regulatory elements in a high-throughput manner as part of the ENCODE project (www.encodeproject.org). Preference will be given to individuals who have a mouse genetic background though this is not a necessity.
